## D.A.'s Report

The Morrow County District Attorney's office at the Morrow County Courthouse in Heppner handled the following business during the past week according to District Attorney, Rick McNerney.

Robert Raymond Cossitt, Echo, was convicted of Driving Under the Influence of Intoxicants and sentenced to a \$352 fine and one year driver's license suspension.

Michael V. Hiatt, Irrigon, plead guilty to Driving While Suspended, a felony, and Resisting Arrest. His sentence was suspended with two years probation and a \$270 fine.

Kenneth J. Perkins, Boardman, was arraigned on charges of Burglary I, Criminal Mischief I, Criminal Mischief II, and Resisting Arrest. Bail has been set at \$3,060 for all of the charges.

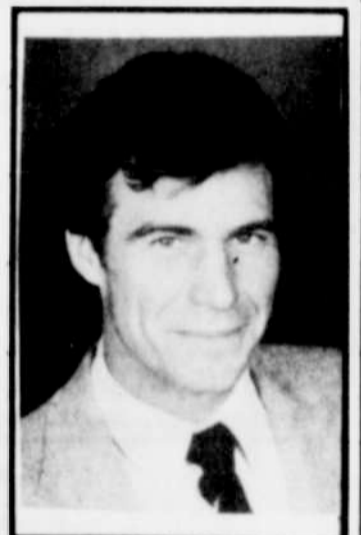
