Floyd W. Hutchins

Floyd W. Hutchins, 77 died Wednesday, Nov. 7, 1984, at his home in Heppner. He had been a resident here for 30 years.

Hutchins was born March 18, 1907, in McMinnville, son of Nathan and Margaret (McDonald) Hutchins.

On Feb. 1, 1931, he married Mary Edna Gillock in Walla Walla. He worked as a police officer in Umatilla for several years before coming to Heppner in 1954, and was a police officer here from 1954 until 1966.

His wife died in 1974.

Surviving are four daughters: Lillian Majors and Flo Connor of Pendleton, Sherry McDaniel of John Day, and Bobbie Angell, Heppner; 13 grandchildren and eight great-grandchildren.

Funeral services were held at 2 p.m. Friday, November 9 at the First Christian Church in Heppner with the Rev. Don Shelton officiating. Musical selections were provided by organist Carley Drake and soloist Ron McDonald.
