Ione grabbed the championship trophy with a 50-39 come from behind victory over Condon.

The Cardinals took a 10 to nine lead in the first quarter. Will Homer kept the Blue Devils close with six points in the quarter.

Condon took a 21 to 17 halftime lead, by taking the second period 12-7. Steve Miller and Todd Barnett each scored four points in the period for Condon.

The Cardinals came right back to regain the lead 32 to 27 after three stanzas. The Cardinals controlled the third stanza 15-6.

Randy McCabe tossed in 12 fourth quarter points, as Ione won 50 to 39. McCabe led all scorers with 18 points. Mark Meyers added 12 to the Cardinal cause.

Chuck Anderson led Condon scoring 10. Homer and Barnett each added eight.

Condon had a 35 to 34 advantage on the boards. For Ione, McCabe grabbed 10 rebounds and Donnie Doherty snared seven.

Meyers passed out five assists. Jeff Ball and Brian Douglas each handed out three more.

The Cards made 22 of 50 field goals for 44 percent. At the line, Ione was 6 of 17 for 35 percent. Condon shot 46 field goals and made 17 for 37 percent. The Blue Devils made five of 13 foul shots for 38 percent.

Ione committed a season-low 16 turnovers. Condon handed the ball over 19 times.

At the conclusion of the boys game, the tournament all-star teams were chosen. The boys team included Randy McCabe and Mark Meyers from Ione, Jon Hankins from Wheeler Co., Todd McGuire from Culver, and Chuck Anderson from Condon.

Farmers in Morrow, Umatilla, and Gilliam Counties have only until December 31, 1984 to let the Farmers Home Administration (FmHA) know if they want to be considered for setting aside part of their FmHA farm debt, Dave R. Fitzsimmons, FmHA County Supervisor said in a recent news release.

"Any farmer who thinks he or she might be eligible for the special set-aside program should contact me without delay so we can make an appointment," Fitzsimmons said.

The actual meeting can be held any time, but the deadline for action for

the appointment is December 31, 1984.

Under the program, which is part of President Reagan's farm credit initiatives announced in September, FmHA can set-aside for five years without interest as much as 25 percent, up to a maximum of \$200,000, of a borrower's FmHA debt if that will restore a positive cash flow for the farmer.

Borrowers have 30 days after receiving notice of the program from FmHA to ask for an appointment to discuss the program.

The Ione boys basketball team came home champions from the Condon Christmas Tournament at Condon on Friday, Dec. 14 and Saturday, Dec. 15.
