

Cards take 56-50 Blue Devilwin

Cards fly over Cougars for 58-50 win 56-50

Ione's boys basketball team took a 56-50 contest over the Condon Blue Devils on Saturday, Jan. 19. The Cardinals are now 5-1 in the Big Sky Conference and 12-2 overall.
In the first period, Ione managed a slim 10 to eight lead then exploded for 22 second quarter points en route to an intermission advantage of 32 to 18. Randy McCabe and Mark Meyers each tossed in eight for the Cardinals in the quarter.
With Meyers scoring eight more in the third period, Ione outscored the Blue Devils 16-15, increasing their margin to 48-33. Chuck Anderson scored eleven for the Blue Devils.
Condon had 17 final period points, compared with only eight for the Cards, but Ione hung on to win 56 to 50. Meyers was the game's high scorer with 26, a season high. McCabe popped in 12 more for the Cardinals. Anderson threw in 21 for

the Blue Devils.
Ione grabbed a 36-27 advantage on the boards. McCabe got ten, Donnie Doherty collected eight, and Mike Rietmann pulled down seven.
Meyers dished out eight of the Cardinal's 15 assists. Ione had 21 turnovers, while Condon had only 10.
From the field, the Cards were an even 50 percent, making 23 of 46 attempts. The Blue Devils were successful on 18 of 61 shots, a 30 percent mark. Ione shot only 48 percent from the free throw line, hitting 10 of 21 tries. Meanwhile, Condon was good on 54 percent of their attempts converting 14 of 26.
Ione is in second place in the Eastern Division of the Big Sky Conference and will face a major task in the Arlington Honkers at Arlington, on Friday, January 25, beginning at 7:30 p.m. Ione then hosts the Wheeler Co. Falcons on Saturday, Jan. 26, in a 7:30 p.m.

With 26 points and 23 rebounds from Randy McCabe, Ione's boys basketball team defeated the Echo Cougars 58-50 on Friday Jan. 18.
Behind McCabe's eight opening quarter points, Ione took a 19 to 10 lead.
Fred Widman tossed in eight points, as Echo won the second period 16-11, to pull within 30 to 26 at the break.
The Cougars took the third quarter 14-12, but still trailed 42-40. Widman, Devin Correa, and Jim Ramos had four for the Cougars, while McCabe put in eight more for the Cardinals.
Echo led early in the final period, but Ione grabbed the period 16-10 and the game, 58 to 50.
Besides McCabe's 26, Mark Mey-

ers added 12 more for the Cards. The inside play of Widman produced 19 for the Cougars, while the outside shooting of Ramos produced 15.
Ione grabbed a 47-32 advantage on the boards. Donnie Doherty hauled in nine and Mike Rietmann eight, plus McCabe's 23.
Meyers handed out six of the Cardinal's 19 assists. McCabe gave out five and Jeff Ball four more. The Cardinals turned the ball over 32 times, compared to 22 for Echo. Meyers also had seven steals and Ball forced nine turnovers.
At the foul line, Ione made a season high 73 percent on eight for 11.
Echo converted 10 of 14, 71 percent. From the floor, the Cards shot 56, making 25, a 45 percent clip. The

Cougars were good on 33 percent, making 20 of 60.

Ione's girl's basketball team dropped to 1-5 in the Big Sky Conference and 3-11 overall, following a 46-31 loss to the Condon Blue Devils on Saturday, Jan. 19.
Michelle Berray sparked Condon with six points in the first quarter. However, Condon's lead was only 10 to eight.
The Cardinals' Deena Hams put in eight second period points, as each team scored 12. The Blue Devils led 22-20 at the break.
Condon increased their advantage to 30-24 by the end of three periods. Condon scored eight points in the period to four for Ione. Berray tossed in eight fourth quarter points, as the Blue Devils took the quarter 16 to seven. The Blue Devils won 46 to 31.
Berray topped all scorers with 21 points. Hams threw in 12 for Ione. Neither team shot very good from

the free throw line. The Cards hit three of 12 shots for 25 percent. Condon was 38 percent, making six of 16. From the floor, Ione converted 14 of 49 attempts, only 29 percent.
The Cardinals hauled in 32 rebounds. Sandi Wright snared 12 and Hams gathered nine. Hams and Patti McElligott each had four steals. Ione turned the ball over 19 times, one of their lowest outputs of the season.

The Blue Devils jumped out to a 14-9 advantage during the first period, behind six inside points from Bob Byrd.
The Cardinals managed a 23 to 19 intermission margin, by outscoring Condon 14-5 in the second quarter. Eric Pointer tossed in six points for the Cardinals.
