Ione's girls basketball team closed out the season with a 53 to 38 loss to the Echo Cougars on Saturday, February 9. Ione closed at 2-8 in the Big Sky Conference and 4-14 overall. Echo took a 14 to three advantage after one period. Jodi Cody pumped in six for Echo. The Cougars gained the second quarter 14-13, to have a 28-16 half-time lead. Connie Baker tossed in six for the Cougars. With Baker putting in seven more during the third period, Echo outscored the Cardinals 15-6. Cody put in six more for Echo, as Deena Hams had all the Cardinal points. Hams gunned in 13 concluding

quarter points as Ione controlled the quarter 16-10. However, the Cougars prevailed 33-28. Hams was the game's leading scorer with 26 points. Baker led Echo, scoring 15. Cody popped in 12 and Katherine Andrews powered in 10. The Cardinals shot 30 percent from the field, making 16 of 53 attempts. At the foul line, Ione hit 35 percent of their shots (6 of 17). Meanwhile, the Cougars connected on five of seven for 71 percent. The Cards pulled down 36 boards. Hams grabbed 14, Candi Rudisill gained six, Sandi Wright and Kim McCabe snared five and Patti McElligott gathered four. Rudisill dished out four assists. Hams got three

Ione's boys basketball team defeated the Echo Cougars by a 63 to 41 count on Saturday, Feb. 9. Echo opened the game taking an early four to one lead. From there Ione went on a 12 to 7 run, to lead 13-11 after one period. The Cardinals used a full court press in the second quarter to outscore the Cougars 18-8 and go up 31 to 19 at the break. Mark Meyers gunned in 10 points for Ione. In the first half alone, the Cougars had 20 turnovers. Ione continued to press in the third quarter and continued to get results. With Meyers and Randy McCabe tossing in six and five points respectively, Ione took the quarter 13 to six. After three, Ione led 44 to 25. Meyers added seven in the fourth period for the Cards who grabbed the period (19 to 6) and the game (63 to 41). Fred Widman pumped in seven for Echo. Meyers topped all scorers, gunning to 27. McCabe threw in 13 more. Ione. Widman had 12 to lead the Cougars. A key to the Cardinal victory was Echo's 36 turnovers, meanwhile committing 29 themselves. The Cards handed out a season high 26 assists, compared to 10 for the Cougars. Meyers dished out seven assists, McCabe gave out six, and Ken Snider passed for four more. Ione grabbed a 44 to 37 advantage on the boards. McCabe pulled down 16. Donnie Doherty snagged eight, Mike Rietmann and Brian Douglas snared six, and Meyers collected five more for Ione.

line, the Cardinals were only three of 11 for 27 percent. The Cougars connected on 13 of 23, a 57 percent mark. Ione finished at 7-3 in the eastern division of the Big Sky Conference and is now 14-4 overall. Ione is tied with the Arlington Honkers for second place. To determine which team will go to the district tournament, the two teams met at Riverside High School in Boardman on Tuesday, Feb. 12. If Ione wins, they will play the Dufur Rangers on Friday, Feb. 15 beginning at 3:30 p.m. If Ione wins that game, they will play the loser of the Helix-Condor game at 8:30 p.m. on Saturday, Feb. 16, with the winner to go to the state tournament. The district tournament will be held at Umatilla High School.

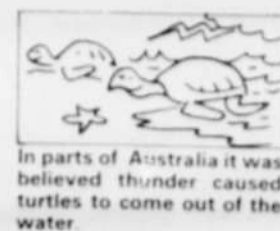

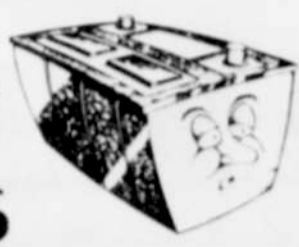
