GENERAL RULES

Morrow County: To be eligible to enter all horses and exhibitors must be Morrow County residents. All horses must be owned and kept in Morrow County at least 60 days prior to time of show. The age of the individual riders will be as of January 1, 1985. Members of immediate family may ride same horse providing classes do not conflict, except the horse being ridden for performance horse points. Show management reserves the right to combine or cancel unfilled classes. All classes shall have three or more horses entered. A three minute gate hold will be given upon request only.

OPEN: All above rules apply to open classes with the exception of owners and horses being residents of Morrow County.

RIBBONS AND AWARDS: Morrow County ribbons to four places. Open class ribbons to six places. Halter: Awards to first place and Champion and Reserve Champion for each division. Morrow County class premiums: **First - \$5, Second - \$4, Third - \$3, Fourth - \$2.** **Champion Performance Horse - \$25 and Silver Award, Reserve Champion Performance Horse - \$15 and Sterling Silver Buckle, Reserve Junior Champion Horse - \$10 and Silver Award.**

OPEN High Point Award to be given to horse having most points in open classes. Performance Class Specifications

16. MC Lead line 5 and under
17. Open Lead line 5 and under

Classes 16 and 17: Entrant will be shown at a walk and trot, led by an adult. Western saddle and bridle with leadline attached. Cannot cross enter with the Walk-trot class or Western Pleasure 12 and under.

18. MC Walk-trot Class 8 and under

19. OPEN Walk-trot Class 8 and under

Classes 18 and 19: No cross entry with 12 and under pleasure class, leadline or other children's performance classes.

20. MC Performance Ponies

21. OPEN Performance Ponies

Classes 20 and 21: Performance ponies up to 56" eligible. Must have a western saddle and equipment. Judged on pony's performance at a walk, trot, and lope. Riders up to and including 12 years of age. Cannot cross enter with leadline or walk-trot classes.

22. OPEN English Pleasure 17 and under: To be shown at a walk, trot and canter. Martingale prohibited. Judged on manners, performance, quality and suitability of horse to rider. Light contact is recommended.

23. OPEN English Pleasure 18 and over: To be shown at a walk, trot, canter, and hand gallop. To stand quietly and back readily. Martingale prohibited. Judged on manners, performance, quality and suitability of horse to rider. Light contact is recommended.

24. OPEN English Equitation 17 and under

25. OPEN English Equitation 18 and over

Classes 24 and 25: To be judged on the seat, hands, performance of horse and rider, and suitability of horse to rider. Back straight and stand quietly. Any modification of hunt or saddle seat tack and attire is acceptable. Appointments not to be judged.

26. OPEN Hunter Hack: All ages; maximum fence height 2½ ft. Tack and appointments to be judged. To be judged on performance and manners, with preference shown to horses
