

covering the jumps with free flowing strides, which jump fences without interrupting rhythm, using proper form. Horses are required to jump two fences. Boots and hard hat required. Rail work both ways.

27. OPEN Working Hunter: All Ages; six fences • maximum height 2½ ft. Tack and attire of hunt seat type. Boots and hard hats required. Tack and appointments not to be judged. To be judged on performance and manners, with preference shown to horses covering the course with free flowing strides, which jump fences without interrupting rhythm, using proper form. Circling once upon entering and once upon leaving is permissible. Any other circling is a disobedience. Failure to follow course or third disobedience anywhere on course is an elimination, as is fall of horse and-or rider. Pattern to be posted prior to show time.

- 28. MC Stock Seat Equitation 12 and under
- 30. MC Stock Seat Equitation 13-17
- 31. MC Stock Seat Equitation - 18 and over
- 32. OPEN Stock Seat Equitation 13-17
- 34. OPEN Stock Seat Equitation 18 and over

Above classes to be judged on seat, hands, and performance of horse and suitability of horse to rider. To be judged as a group at a walk, trot, and canter both directions of the ring. Horses to back readily and stand quietly. Western attire and equipment required. No hackamore bits, wire curbs, or curb chains narrower than ½" permitted. Nosebands, tie downs, or martingales prohibited.

- 35. MC Western Pleasure 12 and under
- 37. MC Western Pleasure 13 - 17
- 38. MC Western Pleasure 18 and over
- 39. OPEN Western Pleasure 17 and under
- 40. OPEN Western Pleasure 18 and over

Classes 35-40: To be shown at a walk, jog, and lope both directions of the ring. Judged on performance and manners. Morrow County riders wishing to compete toward Morrow County Senior Performance Horse Award must enter class 37 instead of age group. Attire and equipments same as stated for classes 28-34.

29. Open Western Pleasure Color - All Ages: Open to Albino, Appaloosas, Buckskins, Duns, Grullas, Paints, Palominos, and Pintos; 14.1 hands and over. To be judged the same as western pleasure classes 35-40. Attire and equipment requirements same as stated for classes 30-34.

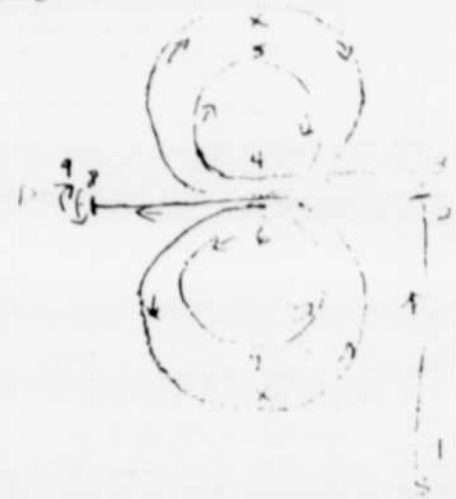
36. MC Jr. Horse Western Pleasure - Jr. Performance Points (+); Open to horses foaled in 1981 and after. Horses to be shown in a standard western bit, one hand on reins; Bosal Hackamore or Ring Snaffle, two hands on reins. To be judged the same as Western Pleasure Classes 35-40. Attire and equipment same as stated for classes 28-34.

41. Open Western Command Class - all ages; To enter the ring at a walk, or trot of intermediate gait. This class is meant to be an advanced pleasure class and the horse may be required to do anything the judge commands. Emphasis shall be placed on the immediate responsiveness of the horse and rider to the judges' commands. Attire and equipment requirements same as stated for classes 28-34.

42. MC Jr. Horse Reining Class (+) Jr. Performance Horse Points; Bosal Hackamore, or ring snaffle without shanks only. No nosebands, tie downs, drawreins or martingales. Two hands permitted on reins.

Pattern for Jr. Reining Horse Class:

1. Run with speed
  2. Sliding stop, Back, Settle Horse
  3. Quarter turn to left
  4. Ride small circle to right - slow
  5. Ride large circle to right - fast
  6. Ride small circle to left - slow
  7. Ride large circle to left - fast
  8. Sliding stop, settle horse
  9. Pivot left - pivot right
- ... Ride to judge - inspection

Change of leads up to discretion of rider; May be interrupted or flying change.  
 43. MC Sr. Reining Horse Class - 5 years and over (x) - Sr. Performance Points; Horses to be ridden with grazing, long shanked snaffle, curb, halfbreed or spade bit. Nosebands, tie downs, draw reins or martingales not permitted. No wire curbs or chain curbs less than ½" in width. One hand on reins.
