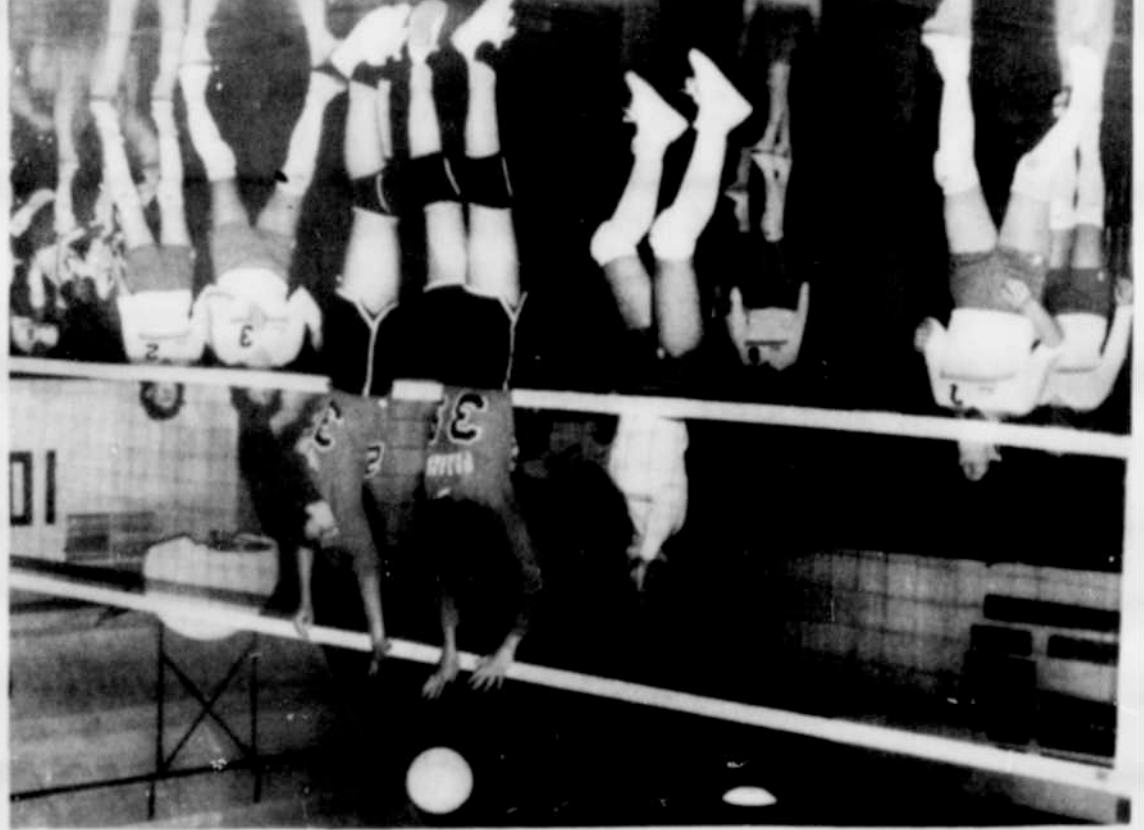
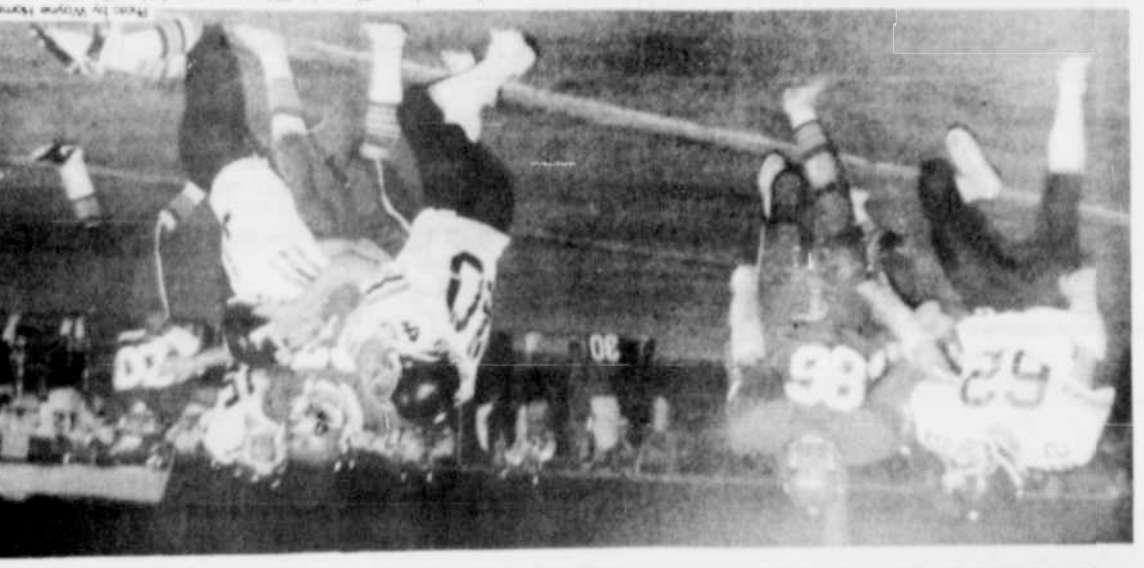


Ione downs Prairie City twice
