**ASCS executive director reminds foreigners to report land transactions**

Judy Buschke, Executive Director of the Morrow County ASCS, reminds foreigners who acquire or transfer any interest other than a security interest in Morrow County's agricultural land to report the transaction within 90 days. "This is a requirement of the Agricultural Foreign Investment Disclosure Act and those who fail to report, or who are late in reporting face possible

penalties," she said. ASCS offices are responsible for keeping track of how much agricultural land is owned or controlled by foreign individuals or interests. Foreign investors have reported owning about 14 million acres of agricultural land in the United States, and 10,240 acres in Morrow County.

According to Ms. Buschke, a foreign disclosure report must be filed when a single foreign individual, organization, or government holds a direct or indirect interest of 10 percent or more; when a group of foreign individuals, organizations, or governments, acting in concert, hold an aggregate interest of 10 percent or more; when a group of foreign individuals, organizations, and governments each with less than 10 percent and not acting in concert hold an aggregate of 50 percent interest or more in agricultural land.

"Agricultural land is any tract of more than 10 acres now in agricultural, forestry, or timber production. This includes land in agricultural use when purchased, as well as land later converted to agricultural use," Buschke said. Foreigners who own or have an interest in 10 acres or less do not need to report unless annual proceeds from the sale of agricultural products grown on these acres exceed \$1,000. "Interest means any right, title, or legal share of ownership in agricultural land, such as partnerships, trusts, estates, or shares in a cooperation that owns agricultural land."

Buschke said individuals or companies that specialize in land holdings, land transfers, or management services should contact the county ASCS office for AFIDA details.

**Teddy Bear workshop scheduled**

Lisa Kock, Corvallis, (the same instructor who taught "Quilt in a day") now has developed plans for a four-hour workshop in which a teddy bear can be completed, says Birdine Tullis, OSU Program Assistant for the Morrow County Extension Service. Lisa will be in Heppner, October 22, 8 to 10 p.m. at the fairgrounds to present the workshop.

Cost of workshop which includes all materials for making a large bear and also those for your choice of garment in which to dress the bear will be \$25. Lisa tells us that similar bears sell for about \$30 retail.

A similar workshop will be held in Condon on October 21 from 8 a.m. to 12 noon for anyone who cannot attend an evening workshop.
