## Universities release new wheat variety

Winter wheat production in Oregon is estimated at 52.8 million bushels based on conditions as of September 1. This is the same as the August 1 forecast, but is a decrease of 20 percent from the 1984 crop. The average yield of winter wheat, at 55.0 bushels per acre, is eight bushels less than last year's record yield. Acreage for harvest is estimated to be 960,000 acres, nine percent less than last year's level of 1,050,000 acres. All wheat production, including spring wheat, amounts to 56.2 million bushels, 18 percent less than the 1984 production. Total United States all wheat production is forecast at 2.4 billion bushels, eight percent less than 1984.

and one percent less than 1983's production. Oregon's barley production is estimated to be 19.8 million bushels, up 14 percent from 1984 and the highest production since 1958. The average yield per acre, at 60.9 bushels, is actually down two bushels from 1984, but the acreage for harvest at 330,000 acres, is up 50,000 acres from last year.

Forecasts of other Oregon field crops as of September 1 are: oats production at 9.1 million bushels, 38 percent greater than in 1984; sugar beet production at 319,000 tons, up four percent from last year; hops production at 8.8 million pounds, up 27 percent from 1984.

voluntary adult education program of the OSU Extension Service. Study groups have been an important part of the Extension education effort for more than 50 years. Participation is voluntary and the setting is informal.

"However, the purpose of Extension study groups is serious," Tullis stresses. "Each group is composed of women and men who are anxious to expand their knowledge and improve their skills in such areas in parenting, food and nutrition, financial management, citizenship, and consumerism."

Study groups are open to all interested people and the groups welcome new members and visitors. The county Extension office in Heppner has a list of meeting times and places for each group. The information is available by calling 676-9642.

However, if there is no study group near you or none meeting at a time that fits your schedule, a new group can be started by anyone at any time.

All that's needed to start a new group is to identify a group of people interested in learning and set up a meeting time and place. Groups range in size from 10 in the Rhea Creek area to over 40 in the North Morrow Group.

Meeting places and times can be set to suit the group. For instance, if all the participants work meetings could be held in a convenient place.

One important requirement, however, is the willingness of a least one member of the group to attend the leader-teacher training sessions prior to each lesson. That's because members of the group volunteer to take turns presenting the information, Tullis explains.

The Extension Service provides leader-teachers with the background material necessary to present the lesson as well as suggestions for how to present the information.

Members of the Extension staff or volunteers in Morrow County are available to help organize and plan for a new study group. For more information, call or stop by the Morrow County Extension office in Heppner.

This matter having come before the Court at its regularly scheduled meeting of 9-26, 1985, and the Court having duly considered the matter, the Court does hereby make the following findings of fact and issues the following CLOSURE ORDER.

That a road commonly known as "Arbuckle Stock Drive" is a county road located in Morrow County, Oregon, in the Umatilla National Forest, southeast of Heppner;

That the road is located in Township 4S, Range 29E, Section 30, and is identified on the attached map which is marked "Exhibit A" and is incorporated herein by reference;

That the owners of the land adjacent to the portion of the Arbuckle Stock Drive which is in question have requested that the road be closed to motor vehicle traffic;

That closing the road between U.S. Forest Service Road No. 5326 (Shaw Creek Grade) and Arbuckle Mountain itself is in the public interest, as the road has become unsuitable for motor vehicle traffic;

That the ORDER of the Roadmaster ordering the closure of said portion of road is attached hereto as Exhibit "B"; THEREFORE: IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE MORROW COUNTY COURT

1) That the county road known as Arbuckle Stock Drive is hereby closed indefinitely from U.S. Forest Service Road No. 5326 (Shaw Creek Grade) south to Arbuckle Mountain;

2) That the closure is effective to prohibit vehicle (not pedestrian) traffic along that portion of the county road;

3) That this closure shall not affect Arbuckle Stock Drive south of Arbuckle Mountain;

4) That this closure is in accordance with Morrow County Ordinance No. MC-C-1-84, passed February 1, 1984;

5) That the County Clerk is instructed to provide copies of this ORDER to the United States of America, through its Forest Service.
