BEFORE THE LAND CONSERVATION AND DEVELOPMENT COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF OREGON IN THE MATTER OF MORROW COUNTY NOTICE OF REQUEST FOR ACKNOWLEDGE OF COMPLIANCE WITH THE STATEWIDE PLANNING GOALS

The Department of Land Conservation and Development has again received a request from Morrow County that its comprehensive plan and land use regulations be acknowledged to be in compliance with the Statewide Planning Goals. In the previous review of this plan, the Land Conservation and Development Commission found that certain aspects of the plan did not comply with Statewide Planning Goals.

The Commission will tentatively review the plan at its meeting on November 21-22, 1985. The review will be based on a report by DLCD staff and comments received from affected local, state and federal agencies and interested persons. Reviewers are advised that the materials submitted may also affect other Goal topics in the jurisdiction's compliance request previously found by the Commission to be ready for acknowledgement.

Comments or objections to the Commission acknowledging the plan must be submitted to the Department of Land Conservation and Development, 1175 Court Street N.E., Salem, Oregon 97310, by October 21, 1985 in order to be addressed in the staff report. All evidence to be submitted for Department and Commission consideration must be submitted by the comment deadline. Evidence submitted following the deadline will not be considered unless the Commission determines the evidence could not have been presented earlier. (See OAR 660-03-020). A copy of the comment or objection letter should also be sent to the affected local jurisdiction.

Copies of the plan are available for review at the Department in Salem and the DLCD Field Offices in Portland (320 SW Stark Street, Room 530) and La Grande (RSI House, EOSC) and the Morrow County Planning Department (Irrigon).
