

Mustangs earn 2nd victory of season

Heppner's varsity football team produced their second victory of the season with an 8 to 0 score over the Wasco County Redsidies on Friday, Oct. 18.

After a Redside punt, the Mustangs got on the scoreboard when David Pedro ran seven yards up the middle, early in the first period. Joe Taylor threw to Tony Clement for the extra points as the Mustangs led eight to nothing. The touchdown was set up when Alex

Lindsay scooted 30 yards down to the Redside seven-yard line.

Neither team could score in the final three quarters. Wasco County had three opportunities in the second quarter, but were turned away all three times.

Heppner had 126 yards of total offense, with all but eight of those rushing.

The Redsidies collected 79 yards of total offense, gaining 61 on the ground. David Tolentino ran back two kickoffs for 45 yards. The

Redsidies lost three fumbles, all of them in Mustang territory.

Defensively for Heppner, Bob Riehl had 15 tackles, Pedro got 11, and Lindsay and Mark Fishburn each had eight. Riehl collected 23 defensive points, and Pedro and Fishburn both had 17 points. Fishburn and Troy Hyatt had three for losses.

"We were too inconsistent on offense," remarked Mustang head coach Tim Birkby. "Once again our defense played well and kept us in the game."

The Mustangs host the winless Pilot Rock Rockets on Friday, Nov. 1 at 7:30 p.m. in the final game of the season for both teams.
