Pesticides found in food

New studies show that much of the produce imported into the U.S. contains pesticide residues, reports an international wildlife magazine. One-fourth of all fruit consumed in the United States is grown on foreign soil, where many pesticides banned in the U.S. are used. Only a tiny fraction of imported food shipments are inspected by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration. Even the, the FDA tests for fewer than half the pesticides which may be applied to foreign-grown produce.
