Accomplishments for 1985

- + Approval received on Dry Fork Watershed Project for developing land treatment alternatives.
- + The Rietmann Canyon Drainage Proposal was reviewed with the Lone Economic Agri-Business Organization. Alternatives being developed.
- + No-Till Annual Cropping of small grains gain importance as a viable alternative. Ten growers used the program with over 2,600 acres planted. A tour was sponsored.
- + A manager was hired for the SWCD program for a part-time position.
- + A Weed Advisory Board was organized in Morrow County and Weed Supervisor hired.
- + A county-wide inventory of "A" list weeds was completed.
- + Two Field Trials demonstrating reseeding techniques were implemented.
- + Participated in the John Day River Basin Water Use Plan.
- + Supported the National and Oregon Associations of Conservation Districts.
- + Supported conservation education in schools and churches.
