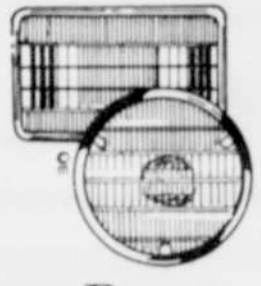

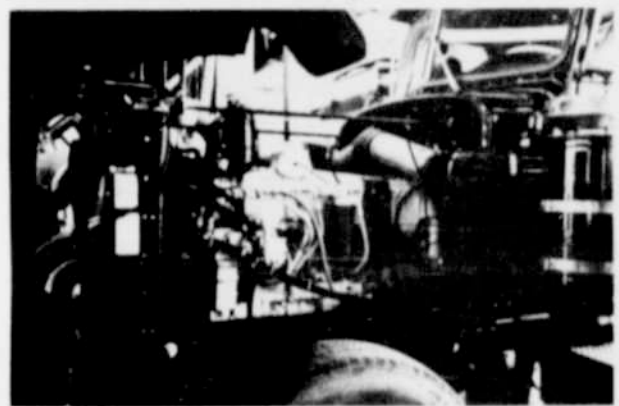

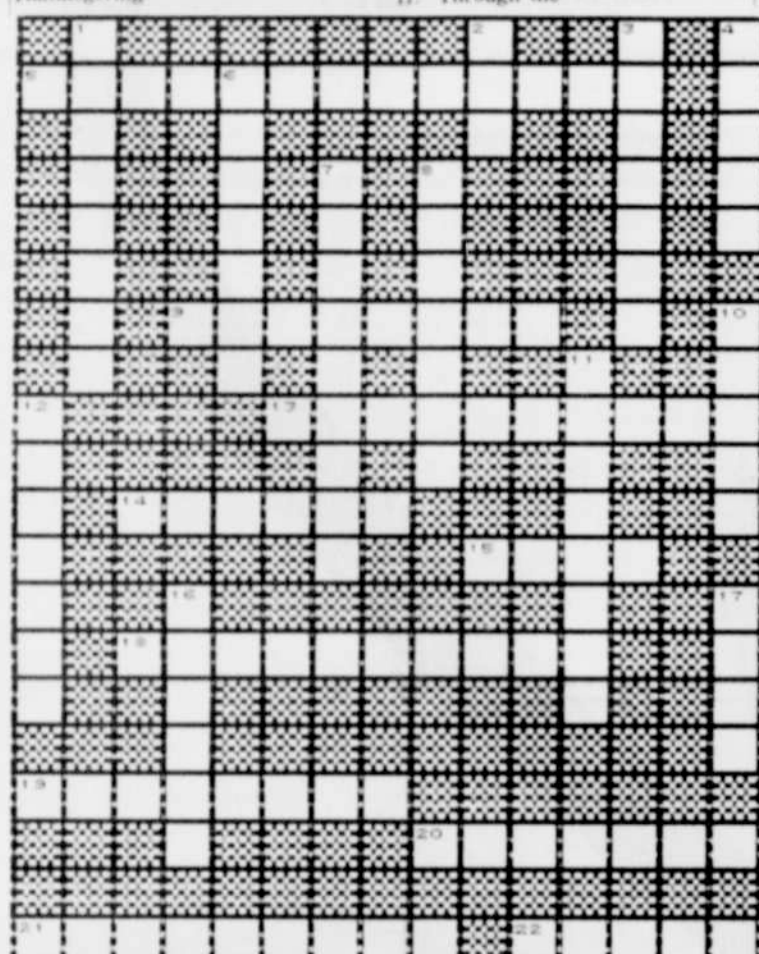

Any person violating any of the provisions of this chapter, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a forfeiture of not less than five dollars nor more than one hundred dollars.
