Ione woman attends assembly

Mrs. Roy W. Lindstrom, Ione, a member of Ruth Locust Chapter No. 32 was one of over 500 members attending the 38th Triennial Assembly of General Grand Chapter, Order of the Eastern Star recently. The World Harvest of Friendship and Light week-long session was held in the Coliseum at the Space Center in Seattle. Over 10,000 members and delegates attended including members from all 50 states, plus Puerto Rico, Luzon and Guam, Mexico, Japan, Visayas and Mindanao, Italy, Western Germany, Saudi Arabia, Philippines, all the provinces of Canada, Bermuda, Scotland, Republic of China, Panama, and Australia, who has just completed chartering their own General Grand Chapter.

Presiding officers at the Assembly were Mrs. Carol Strizek of Seattle, WA, Most Worthy Grand Matron and David Miller of Goshen, Indiana, Most Worthy Grand Patron.

Oregon delegates were pleased with the election of Mrs. Dorothy Dewing, Worthy Grand Esther, from Klamath Falls, to the office of Right Worthy Grand Trustee for a term of six years, said an order spokesperson. This office is the first of several offices leading to election of the Most Worthy Grand Matron.

The cavalcade and tribute to all the state and country flags was very impressive as was the pageantry and script of various members in

their native costumes.

In addition to the business meetings many social affairs and receptions were held throughout the city hosted by different states. Among the outstanding entertainment, continued the spokesperson, was a concert by the renowned twin pianists, Ferrante and Teicher, who have many recordings to their credit. Also recording artists, The Bortbers Four, performed.

The Order of the Eastern Star is a fraternal and social order dedicated to charity and during the last triennial has contributed over six million dollars to welfare funds and to the support of the Peace Garden, which borders Canada and the United States.

The largest funds were donated to Cancer Research, which received over \$1,800,000; ESTARL (Eastern Star Awards for Religious Training), \$2,200,000; Heart Fund, \$619,000; Knights Templar Eye Foundation, \$517,000; Masonic and Eastern Star Homes, \$282,000; Peace Garden, \$13,000; and for miscellaneous charities totaling over \$417,000 donated to Shriners Hospitals, Multiple Sclerosis Fund, Diabetes Fund, Lung Assoc., Cripples Childrens Fund etc. These amounts are not from large companies, but from individual members' contributions, concluded the spokesperson.
