The Fillies jumped out to an early lead in the first quarter to make it a tough competition. The Rockets came as close as two points to the Fillies, but Heppner decided they needed this win and put the Rockets away.

The Fillies shooting percentage did hurt them somewhat, but their defense kept them in the game.

For the Rockets, Remi Reeser led the team with 14 points and Karin Doherty added 13.

Bad breaks contribute to defeat of girl Cardinals

Heppner's boys basketball team led from start to finish and never was seriously threatened when they ran over the Pilot Rock Rockets 82-41 on Friday, Jan. 17.

The 82 points were the most the Mustangs have scored this season and it was also their most lopsided victory of the season. The Mustangs had a +87 rating on coach Brent Eggers' rating system, one of the highest marks any of his previous teams has had.

Heppner ran off the first 10 points of the game and had 10 first quarter assists to take a 22-6 edge. Todd Lindsay fired in 10 points, while Tony Clement and Wayne Wilgers each added six.

Rick Rasmussen came off the bench to spark the Rockets in the second period, but it wasn't enough as the Mustangs reeled off 18 more points to 11 for the Rockets, carrying a comfortable 40-17 advantage into the locker room. Rasmussen hit for nine Rocket points.

Lindsay with nine points and Wilgers with eight more lifted Heppner to a 61-34 cushion after three quarters.

The Mustangs put in 21 more points during the final frame while Pilot Rock had but seven to make the concluding count 82-41.

Lindsay gunned in a season-high 23 points to lead a balanced Mustang attack. Rasmussen chalked up 18 to lead the Rockets.

Heppner accumulated season-highs in both assists (26) and rebounds (53). Duane Ball dealt out seven assists, while Keith Kenison racked up 13 rebounds. Lindsay clutched 12 more missed shots and Trent Harrison ripped down a career-high 10 more. The Mustangs suffered 26 turnovers, but just 7 in the first half.

"We came out prepared and as a result played very well," said Eggers. "Really the game was over with at halftime."

Some bad breaks saw the lone Cardinal girls go down in defeat Saturday in their game against Wheeler 34 to 35. They're now 2-2 in league play. Patti McEligott was lead scorer with 13 points followed by Sandi Wright with 10 points.

Coach Jocelyn Jones says her girls played good, hard ball in spite of the out come.
