SHALL MORROW COUNTY LEVY \$381,694 OUTSIDE THE TAX BASE FOR PIONEER MEMORIAL HOSPITAL OPERATIONS DURING THE FISCAL YEAR 1986-87?

EXPLANATION

The purpose of this levy is to provide funds to balance the Pioneer Memorial Hospital operating budget. The Hospital budget includes hospital in-patient care, emergency care, and the Nursing Home. The total hospital levy is \$381,694, which includes six percent for taxes not expected to be received. The tax rate for the Hospital operations will be approximately \$ 4.48 per \$1,000 valuation, which will be included in the total tax rate for Morrow County operations. The estimated tax cost for this measure is an estimate only based on the best information available from the County Assessor at the time of the estimate.
