The lucky winner may want to try the following recipe with part of the beef purchased on his gift certificate:

Chinese Pepper Steak
 1 pound top round steak, cut $\frac{3}{4}$ to 1" thick
 1 T. cornstarch
 $\frac{1}{2}$ t. sugar
 $\frac{1}{4}$ t. ginger
 $\frac{1}{4}$ c. soy sauce*
 3 medium green peppers
 3 small tomatoes
 2 tablespoons cooking oil
 1 clove garlic, minced
 $\frac{1}{4}$ c. water

Partially freeze steak to firm and slice diagonally across the grain in-

to very thin strips. Combine cornstarch, sugar and ginger and stir in soy sauce. Pour mixture over meat and stir. Cut green peppers into thin strips and cut tomatoes into wedges.

Quickly brown beef strips ($\frac{1}{2}$ at a time) in hot oil and remove from pan. Reduce heat; add green pepper, garlic and water to pan and cook until green pepper is tender-crisp, 5 to

6 minutes. Stir in meat and tomatoes and heat through. 4 servings.

*Substituting light soy sauce will reduce sodium content by about one-half.

Ag tours slated next week
