

Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office at the Morrow County Courthouse in Heppner reports handling or dispatching the following business during the past week:

June 23, the Sheriff's Office responded to a non-injury accident on Bombing Range Road.

Parents liable for kids fireworks

Oregon firefighters preparing for the usual increase in fire-works-related fires during the Fourth of July holiday have some words of warning for parents of children who might cause such fires.

New state laws went into effect in January to make parents liable for up to \$5,000 worth of damage caused by children playing with fireworks, plus the cost of fighting the fireworks-related fires.

Last year in Oregon there were 573 fireworks-caused fires reported to the state fire marshal's office through Aug. 31. The fires caused an estimated property loss of \$260,945.

In Oregon, anything that explodes, flies in the air or moves very far on the ground is prohibited, unless the seller has a proper permit from the state fire marshal's office.
