Scott began singing for weddings and other special events four years ago. This is the first year he and his wife Angie are performing at county fairs. After the Heppner appearance, they are performing at the Central Washington State Fair in Yakima during September.

The Scotts' concert will feature Gospel music, and a patriotic salute to the U.S.

## Wheat growers sponsor 4-H baking contest

Oregon Wheat Growers' League has recently revised their 4-H baking contest to allow all counties to participate.

Formerly titled the "Multi-Use Contest," it is now "Wheat and You". The contest remains basically the same. Any 4-H member may prepare a baked product at home using their choice of wheat products (cracked wheat, ala, wheat germ, etc.) and bring it to the fair for exhibit and judging. There are Junior, Intermediate and Senior divisions.

A new rule this year requires the 4-H'er to include, in 25-words or less, an explanation of the product's nutritional value and why he/she chose that particular product. This must be attached to the exhibit along with the recipe on a 5x7 card.

Valuable cash prizes and a special ribbon is awarded best in each of the three divisions.
