 Willow Creek Park District
 Notice is hereby given that on Tuesday, November 4, 1986, an election will be held in Willow Creek Park District, Morrow County, Oregon. The polls will be open from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. The following shall be the ballot title for the measure submitted to the electors thereof:

Caption: One year construction levy for 1986-87 Fiscal Year.

Question: Shall Willow Creek Park District Levy \$263,000.00 in 1986-87 to permit construction of park facilities.

Explanation: Willow Creek Park District is a new district which has no tax base. The initial project of the Park District is to establish a camping area and beach for the Willow Creek Dam Park. Initial construction costs for the park are \$263,000.00 to establish camper pads with hook ups, restrooms, parking area, swimming beach and beach access and landscaping. The one year construction levy will result in an estimated tax rate of \$1.44 per \$1,000.00 of assessed valuation.

The estimated tax cost of this measure is an ESTIMATE ONLY based on the best information available from the County Assessor at the time of estimate (ORS 310-385).

 Willow Creek Park District

Notice is hereby given that on Tuesday, November 4, 1986, an election will be held in Willow Creek Park District, Morrow County, Oregon. The polls will be open from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. The following shall be the ballot title for the measure submitted to the electors thereof:

Caption: Establishing a Tax Base for Willow Creek Park District.

Question: Shall Willow Creek Park District establish a \$30,000.00 tax base to permit raising money for operation and maintenance of facilities.

Explanation: The district established in 1986 has no tax base. The Army Corps of Engineers wants a tax base established prior to granting a long term lease of the park area. \$30,000.00 will be adequate to provide for maintenance and operation of the park at Willow Creek Dam after development is complete. The tax base levy will result in an estimated tax rate of \$1.17 per \$1,000.00 of assessed valuation.

The estimated tax cost of this measure is an ESTIMATE ONLY based on the best information available from the county assessor at the time of estimate (ORS 310-395).

 Heppner, Morrow

Notice is hereby given that on November 4, 1986, an election will be held in Heppner, Morrow County, Oregon. The polls will be open from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. The following shall be the ballot title for the measure submitted to the electors thereof:

Caption: Three Year Street Improvement Serial Levy.

Question: Shall the City of Heppner levy \$100,000.00 for three years outside the tax base for street improvement beginning 1987-88?

Explanation: The City of Heppner's tax base does not provide the necessary money to repair the deteriorating streets and provide proper curbing for storm drains for vehicle and pedestrian safety. The work will include repair for underground water and sewer lines. The \$100,000.00 would be levied for three consecutive years providing \$300,000.00 for street improvement purposes. The estimated tax rate for the first year of the three year levy is \$3.85 per thousand.

The estimated tax cost for this measure is an ESTIMATE ONLY based on the best information available from the County assessor at the time of the estimate.
