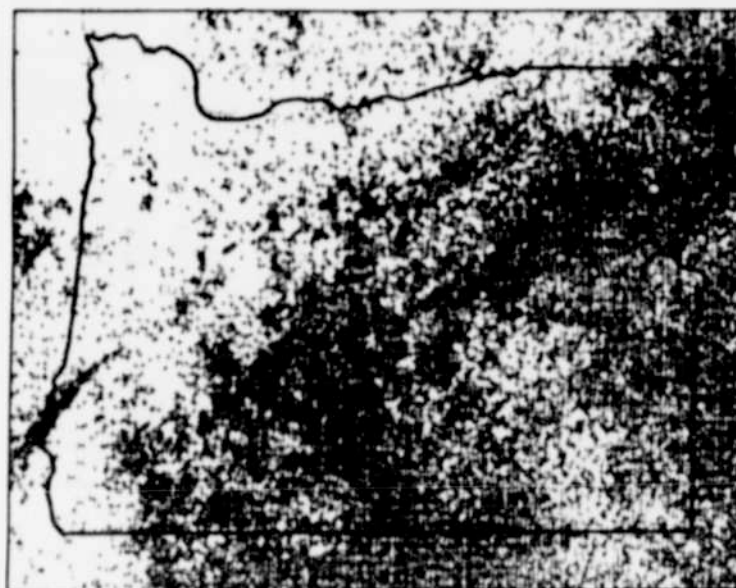


Lightning in Oregon

Annual Work Plan

July 1, 1986 - June 30, 1987

The mission of the Morrow Soil and Water Conservation District is to conserve, protect and develop soil and water and other related resources for the economic and en-

vironmental benefit of the people of Morrow County.

OBJECTIVE I: Reducing excessive soil erosion on the dry cropland soils of Morrow County will be the highest priority within the Morrow SWCD program.

OBJECTIVE III: Improve and develop water resources in Morrow

OBJECTIVE II: Develop an SWCD program geared at addressing the resource issues in Morrow County.

OBJECTIVE IV: Oversee a weed control program in Morrow County to reduce, control or eradicate serious or noxious weeds; and main-

tain or improve conditions of range areas infested with these weeds.

OBJECTIVE V: Promote soil and water conservation through education.

Accomplishments

Jul. 1, 1985 - Jun. 30, 1986

- ★ Land treatment plan for Dry Fork Watershed Project completed and approved for funding.
- ★ Rietmann Canyon flood control project initiated. 15,060 feet of terraces constructed.
- ★ No-till annual cropping and no-till chemical fallow being used as a viable alternative in conservation cropping systems. Approximately 2,500 acres was planted using these methods.
- ★ One field trial on reseeding deteriorated range land was completed.
- ★ Supported the National and Oregon Association at Conservation Districts.
- ★ Supported conservation education in schools and churches.
- ★ Conservation Reserve Program implemented. April and June sign-ups. 105 contracts for 36,925 acres.

Other Accomplishments

- Individuals assisted - 132.
- Individuals applying practices - 56.
- Resource system plans, terrace systems - 21; 149,423 ft.
- Reduce-till systems, 2,845 acres.
- No-till systems - four; 2,410 acres.
- Animal waste storage pond - one.
- Tile drainage - two; 2,960 ft.
- Streambank protection projects - two.
- Waterways - one.
- Grass seeding (non-CRP) - five; 380 ft.
