New law to affect liquor services and licensees

A new law in Oregon, which will go into effect after Jan. 1, 1987, will affect annually about 26,000 Oregonians who serve liquor by the drink and owners of businesses which sell alcohol by the drink.

Oregon's mandatory Alcohol Server Education, enacted by the 1985 Oregon legislature, will require alcohol servers and owners of licensed establishments that sell liquor by the drink to take a course in alcohol server education.

Servers must pass an examination to receive a new service permit or to renew a service permit. Service permits are issued for a five-year period. More than 100,000 Oregonians have service permits.

Owners of most businesses licensed to sell liquor by the drink will be required to take the course in server education annually. Liquor licenses are renewed every year. There are about 4,500 licensees who serve liquor by the drink in Oregon.

Oregon is the first state in the nation to enact server education legislation. The restaurant and beverage industry initiated the legislation to help servers and licensees deal with the inherent problems of serving alcohol.

"The education will increase servers' understanding of their legal and professional duties of serving alcoholic beverages," said Darlene Meyer, Oregon Liquor Control Commission. She is the manager of the Alcohol Education Program which is administered by the Liquor Commission.

The commission developed a model curriculum for the training and is certifying providers of the course throughout the state.

Providers, who will offer the course, will inform servers and licensees about the availability of the classes. Local field offices of the Liquor Commission will also have information about classes in alcohol server education. The first classes in alcohol server education should be presented early in December, Meyer said.

The class will be a six to eight hour presentation. Potential providers anticipate the course will cost about \$30 to \$50, according to Meyer.

Students will take an exam at the end of the course. If a student does not pass the exam, he or she will be able to take the exam again two times at a commission field office.
