

## City asking grant to improve water system

City of Heppner is applying for a Technical Assistance grant for a study of improvement of the city's water system. The grant will be for \$7,500 and would be under the Oregon Community Development Program.

This is the first step in obtaining a grant to update the water, sewer and streets of the city.

A proposed three-year serial levy of \$100,000 per year to finance the work was rejected by the voters this fall.

At a public hearing held Monday on the proposal only one out of several Heppner citizens present opposed the grant request. Ken Key, who does not live in the city, said it was an improper use of tax money.

Bob Jepsen, Heppner, was elected chairman of Morrow County Republican Central Committee at an organizational meeting Saturday.

Jepsen, who operates a 2400 acre wheat and barley farm 18 miles west of Heppner, has been active in the Republican Party for many years. He has served as county chairman of the Elect Bob Packwood Committee since the senator first ran for the national office, and has served as chairman of Farmers to Re-elect Packwood on the State level. He worked in the successful campaign to elect Louis Carlson Judge of Morrow County in the November election. He and his wife Suzanne have served on the county Central Committee for the Republican Party for about 15 years.

A native of Heppner, Jepsen has taken an active part in many farm organizations, holding offices on the county, state, and federal level. He has served as state president of Oregon Agricultural Stabilization and Conservation Service, of Oregon Wheat Growers League, and on many county and state committees in both organizations. He represented eight Western states on the National Wheat Industry Council, and is currently a member of the Governor's Advisory Council on Maritime Affairs.

On the county level he is chairman of Morrow County Long Range Planning Committee, of the county Extension Advisory Council, and of the county policy-making road committee.

Activities include church work on the local, county, state and national level. He has served as president of Willow Creek Country Club, member of Arbutle Ski Patrol, and worked widely with youth in many organizations. He has taught classes in amateur radio and served as Communications director of Morrow County Civil Defense.

Jepsen said his goal is to have a unified county party working for election of more Republicans. He wants to increase the number of Republican registrations in the county, and will spearhead Morrow County Republican Central Committee in becoming more active in community and county affairs.

Other officers elected were Gladys Hobbs, Irrigon, retired teacher, vice chairperson and Avon Melby, Heppner, reporter for Heppner Gazette-Times and KUMA radio, secretary-treasurer. The chairman and vice chairman are delegates to the Oregon Republican Party and vote in elections on the state basis. Alternate delegates represent them if they are unable to attend. John Lovett, Ione, Morrow County Grain Growers employee, was elected alternate for Jepsen. Suzanne Jepsen was elected alternate for Hobbs.

There was only one nomination for each office and all were elected by unanimous vote.

Nine positions in county precincts were not filled in voting last May. They were filled by appointment by the central committee. A set of bylaws was adopted.

Plans were made for a no-host evening dinner meeting Jan. 7 at the Dodge City Inn in Boardman. Jepsen will announce appointments of precinct people to working committees in the newly organized central committee.
