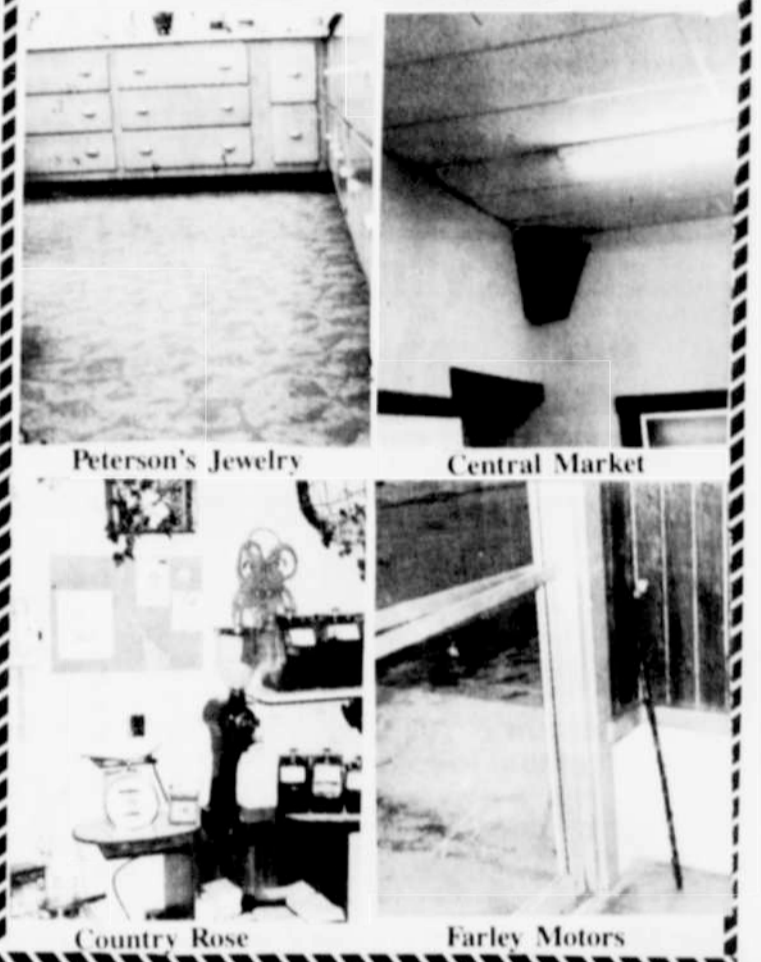
Dorothy had to fillout an extensive application which asked many questions about her project of 10 Suffolk ewes, leadership abilities, and work
