Recipe

Irish Soda Bread

Traditionally Irish, soda bread deserves a place in any and every American kitchen. Toast and butter it for breakfast, or serve it with soup and salad at lunch time.

- 4 cups Western Family flour
- 1 tablespoon Western Family sugar
- 1 teaspoon Western Family salt
- 1 1/2 teaspoons baking soda
- 1 teaspoon baking powder
- 1 3/4 cups buttermilk
- 1 cup raisins
- 2 tablespoons caraway seeds

Preheat oven to 350 degrees F. Combine flour, sugar, salt, soda and baking powder and sift together. Add buttermilk and stir until just blended. Fold in raisins and caraway seeds. Turn dough out onto a floured pastry board and knead, turning and stretching the dough, for 3 minutes. Shape into a round ball and bake on a greased cookie sheet 1 hour and 10 minutes, or until loaf sounds hollow when tapped with a knuckle.
