**Ione team plays in tournament**

 The Ione Cardinals participated in the Morrow County Tournament on December 4 and 5 in Ione. The teams that participated in the event were Heppner, Riverside, Ione and Catlin-Gable.

On the first night of the tournament, the Cardinal boys team drew Catlin-Gable. The game proved to be a very good one and one of the closest of the entire tournament. The scoring leader for Ione was senior guard Kenny Snider who poured in 19 points, senior guard Kevin Ball was second with 15, while junior forward Dustin Padberg also chipped in with 13 points.

The Cardinals didn't play very well in the first half getting outscored 41 to 29. Fortunately, for the Cards, the Catlin Gable Eagles played a horrible game from free throw line shooting only 4 out of 25.

The Cardinals fired up a fierce rally in the fourth quarter outscoring the Eagles by 7 points, but time was the major factor in the game for Ione who fell short 69-65.

The Eagles were led by Roger Gantz who scored 21 points, and Phil Buchanan who scored 20 points in their tournament win that advanced them to the final game with Heppner who had beaten Riverside earlier that day.

The Lady Cardinals also drew the Eagles from Catlin Gable for their first round game of the tournament. The game proved to be a very low scoring contest for both teams. Sophomore forward Jo Cupps led the Lady Cards with 10 points.

Both teams fought hard but the Catlin Gable Eagles seemed better prepared and better conditioned. Catlin Gable was led by Weinstein who scored 10 points in their win against the Cardinals.

Ione made their best effort in the game late in the fourth quarter only getting outscored 14-10.

Since Ione had lost their opening day game for both their teams they went on to play in the consolation round on Saturday. The Ione boys team went on to play Riverside while the Ione girls team went on to face Heppner girls to decide third and fourth place.

The Riverside boys team dominated the Ione Cardinals with their tremendous size, namely 6' 8" center Robb Rea who scored 21 points (10 in the first quarter).

The Cardinals led by junior Dustin Padberg who scored 19 points and snagged 4 rebounds. The Pirates ran away with the consolation match outscoring the Cards 74-48.

The girls team proved to have a closer game with the Heppner girls. The Cards were led with strong play by sophomore s Jo Cupps who

scored 9 points, Darcee Padberg scored 6 points and Mary Cupps and Amy Wagenblast added 5 points apiece to round the major part of the lone offense.

Ione scored 29 points against Heppner but early on the scoring was few and far between. The score was only 2-2 after the first quarter. Junior Tami Lindsay scored 11 points and was the game's leading scorer.
