individuals with the strongest backs, best sidewalk supervisor, etc.

Group sign-up sheets are available around town and have been distributed to local employers. Certain groups have already been identified, however, anyone wishing to organize a group effort may contact Kuhn and Spicer for a sign-up sheet.
