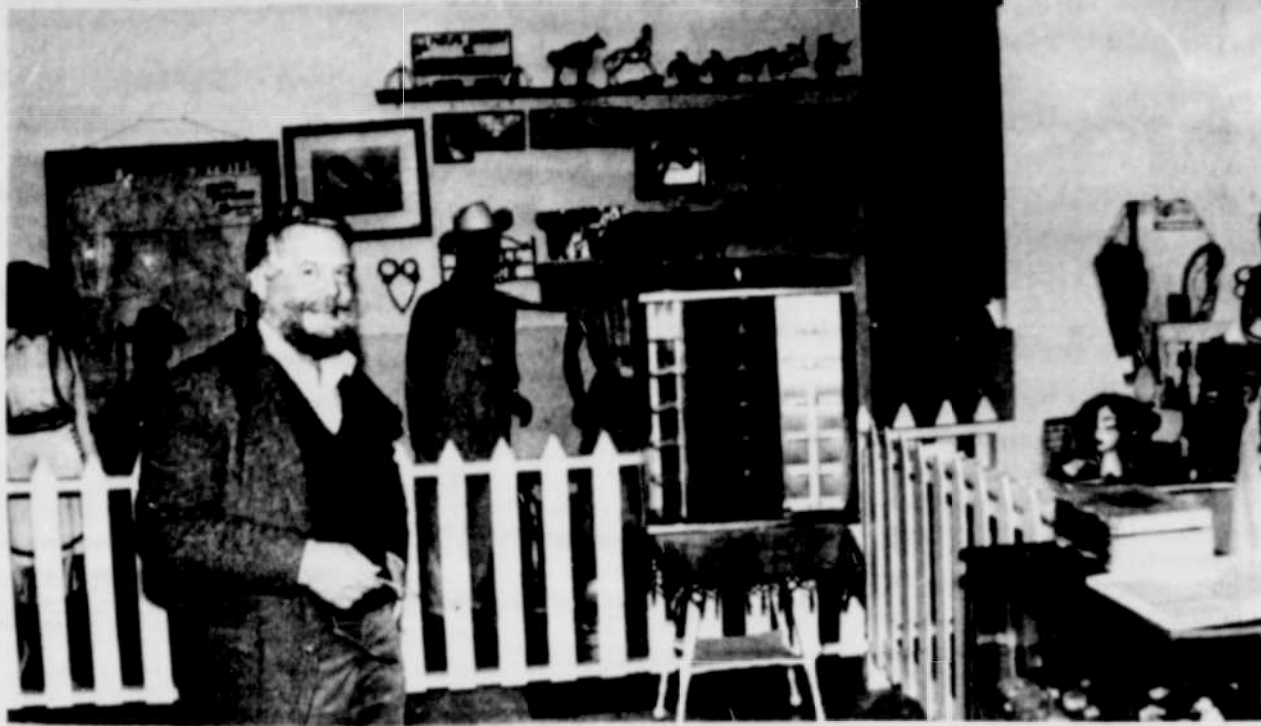


## Mayor of Portland visits Museum

## 1988 Western Regional 4-H Leaders Forum

Geri Grieb and Lynnea Meakins returned last week from Cody, Wyo. where they attended the 1988 Western Regional 4-H Leaders Forum.

Grieb and Meakins were among 18 leaders from Oregon participating in the March 16-20 conference designed to help volunteer leaders by enhancing leadership skills and developing ideas to improve local programs. The five-day event brought together more than 400 leaders from 13 western states and 4 countries.

In keeping with the theme, 4-H Frontiers, Past and Present, the forum presented tours, a frontier festival and 61 workshops. These skill sessions included project, idea, and (how to) mini courses in every area of 4-H, with a three hour kick-off with Dr. Edwin Amend who directed the hands on (Group Leadership and Me) for every participant.

Grieb said the most interesting and informative session dealt with personality styles. We learned that knowing who we are and why we act

the way we do, helps us respond and communicate effectively with others.

Meakins found the most interesting session to be all about 4-H rodeo. New Mexico has a strong 4-H rodeo program that they shared with leaders from other states. The rodeo program stresses safety and it helps to keep the older members in 4-H.

The Capstone address was given by Dr. James Kern, a nationally recognized leader on education and family. "Kern is an outstanding speaker, I was glad for the opportunity to hear him speak," said Grieb.

The forum was conducted by the cooperative extension service of the state land-grant universities in cooperation with the U.S. Department of Agriculture, the National 4-H Council and volunteer leaders from Wyoming. Financial assistance is arranged by the National 4-H Council, with funding by J.C. Penny Company and it's member stores throughout the western states. Additional funding came from corporations throughout Wyoming and the west.

More particulars are needed for the project. The annual meeting for October was also discussed, and it is hoped that there will be a speaker from the Oregon Historical Society available, special music and other entertainment as well as the regular meeting and the election of Board members.
