

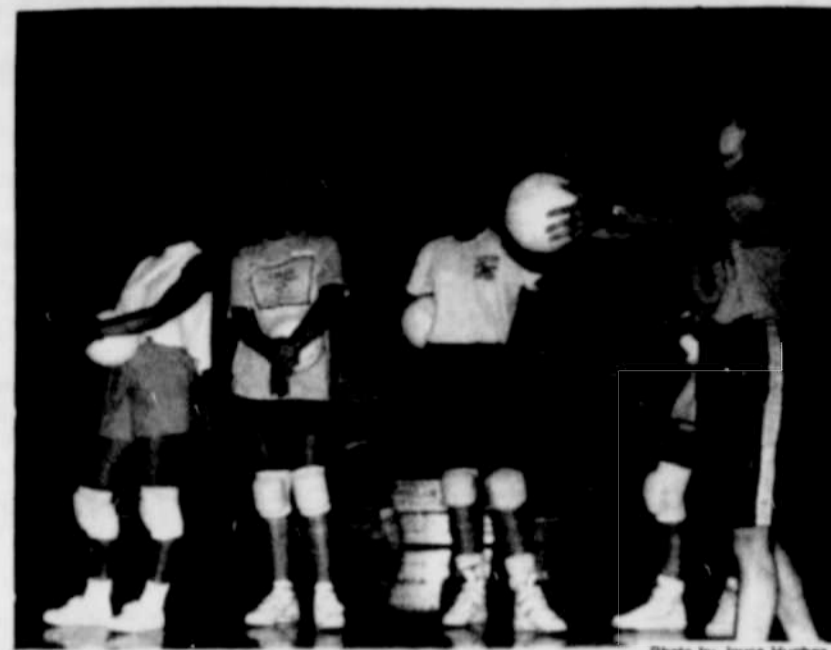
St Pat's committee to discuss purchase
