The Morrow County fairgrounds is taking on some new looks as work proceeds in preparing for the 1988 Fair and Rodeo, August 17-21.

The Rodeo Committee held a work day and replaced ties and boards on the corrals and pens.

Ed Struthers, the caretaker for the fairgrounds, is hard at work doing more than one project at a time. Presently they're adding a 14'x12' outdoor stage to the picnic area. This will be utilized throughout fair for various activities and demonstrations.

Also, the pavilion, dormitory, Snack Shack, Buckaroo Concession Stand and other smaller buildings are receiving a Pearl Gray coat of paint. "It sure enhances the buildings to have the fresh paint on them," remarked Michelle Wallis, Fair Office helper.

The Commercial Crops Display area in the barn has received a 12'x70' concrete slab flooring. Future plans will call for more concrete under the grandstand area in this same barn.

The Poultry and Small Animal barn has been made lighter and remodeled with the addition of new window panels and door.

The Hog Ring has been enlarged and new wiring placed on the outer walls.
