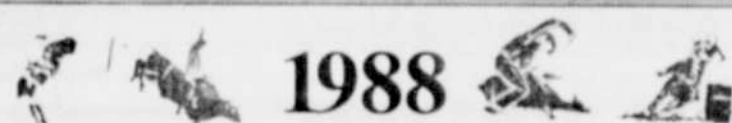


Ring toss game will be back

Releases must be signed before the start of slack if you are a team roper; open calf roper or steer wrestler as first go will be in slack starting at 4 p.m. Friday, August 19. All other releases are to be signed before competing. Parents or guardians need to sign for anyone under 18. Call 422-7104 for further information and to enter Monday, August 8.

tryouts include: being a Morrow Co. resident; 16 years of age but not more than 21 by August 1; must ride a horse, conduct herself in a mature, courteous and ladylike manner; must be able to relate to the general public at parades, luncheons and other events; be able to advertise the fair and rodeo and get along with others.
