There will be a major change in the livestock division at this year's Morrow County Fair. 4-H and FFA large animal conformation classes will be combined.

This change will result in there being one overall and official champion in each division. It will simplify establishing a sale order and it will make larger classes which will make a better show for both spectators and participants.

With the excellent cooperation that exists in Morrow County between 4-H and FFA it just makes sense to

combine the small conformation classes into larger more meaningful classes.

Combining the 4-H and FFA conformation classes has been done at several other shows throughout the state with good results.

FFA and 4-H will show in separate Showmanship contests against members of their own organization.
