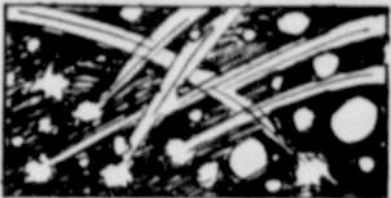
Both players had outstanding games, and are expected to continue throughout the season.

Wildlife and Nature Facts and Fillers

**How much water does a big tree need?** A large leafy tree may take up as much as 240 gallons (900 liters) of water from the soil every day. That would fill the average bathtub more than three times.

**Sometimes called "air plants,"** Tillandsia plants absorb moisture and nourishment directly from rain and fog in the air through specialized scales on the surface of their leaves. The plant's spiny leaves act as roots, drawing in nutrients, while the roots mainly anchor the plant to a tree or rock.



Most of the 100 million meteors that enter the Earth's atmosphere each day burn up and filter down to Earth as dust. The total weight of this dust that falls in one year is estimated to be four million tons.
