Crime

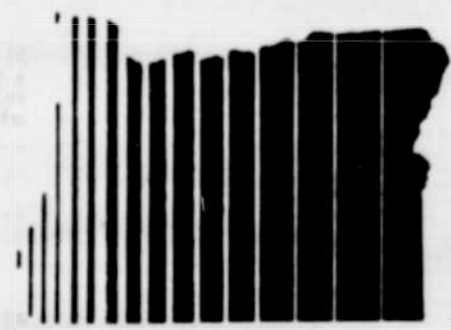
