NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given that the City of Heppner will hold a public hearing on November 7, 1988 on the City's proposed Oregon Community Development Block Grant Program Application.

1. The City of Heppner will conduct a public hearing at the Heppner City Hall at 7:00 p.m. on November 7, 1988 to solicit citizen views, provide citizens specific information, and to discuss projects pertaining to the City's proposal for submitting an application for an Oregon Community Development Block Grant. Projects that are eligible for funding under the Program include Public Works Projects, Housing and Community Facilities, and Technical Assistance Projects.

2. The purpose of this meeting is to involve the citizens of Heppner in all stages of the Oregon Community Development Block Grant Program. The City is encouraging participation by persons or groups representing low to moderate income citizens or citizens who are economically disadvantaged or handicapped to attend and participate in this hearing process.

3. Written records of the proceedings will be kept and be available for all to review at City Hall. A second hearing to outline and discuss a specific project application is planned for December 5, 1988.
