Saturday, December 11, the lone Cardinal boys team faced off with the Condon Blue Devils for the Championship title of the Condon Christmas Tournament.

The Cardinals used the three-point shot as an offensive key early in the game as seniors Brian Ball eased two in the first quarter. Condon's Dan Durfy held 13 of Condon's 18 first quarter points with lone in close with 16.

The lone defense held Durfy to only two points in the second quarter but couldn't capitalize on their advantage as freshman Kyle Broderick held lone's only second quarter points with one field goal and a 3 pointer.
