FINALE LP SALE
Morrow County Oregon
USDA - Forest Service

An Environmental Assessment that addresses the salvage of timber for the Finale LP Salvage Sale is available for the public review at the District Ranger's Office in Heppner, Oregon and the Forest Supervisor's Office in Pendleton, Oregon.

The Finale Sale is located in portions of T.5S., R.28E and T.5S., R.29E., W.M. surveyed.

Alternative A salvages 1.05 MMBF of insect killed lodgepole pine while maximizing potential for wood fiber production on 66 acres. Big game and livestock access is also maintained on 66 acres while big game disturbance is temporary and scattered over a wide area. Sale activities and hunter conflicts are also minimized.

Alternative B is the "No Action" alternative. This means no salvage at this time and precludes future salvage as the material will have deteriorated. Fiber production will remain below potential. Sixty-six acres will receive little use by big game and livestock as access will be blocked by down, jackstrawed lodgepole pine. With no harvest activity there would be no disturbance to big game and no conflict between sale activity and rifle elk hunters.

Based on the Environmental Analysis, I have selected Alternative A for the development of this sale.

Alternative A provides the best combination of biological, physical, and economic benefits and is considered to be the recommended alternative. This alternative salvages mortality, maximizes long term fiber production and improves big game and livestock access with only a temporary scattered disturbance of big game. Potential for conflict between rifle elk hunters and sale activity is minimized thereby maintaining a quality hunt in a road closure area.

Based on the Environmental Analysis and previous experience I have determined that timber harvest activities and road construction will have no significant adverse environmental effects individually or cumulatively to either the biological or physical components of the human environment and is within the scope of the Heppner Planning Unit Environmental Impact Statement. Therefore, I find an Environmental

Impact Statement is not needed. Implementation of this project may take place immediately upon the signing and dating of this Decision Notice.

This decision is subject to administrative review (appeal) to 36 CFR 211.18. A written notice of appeal must be filed with the District Ranger within 45 days from the date of this Decision Notice.
