With the good weather we are having the road department blades are working on Keck Canyon, Bob Lovgren, Social Ridge and Lone Rock roads, with crushed rock being applied as time and equipment allows.

Stripping of Lone-Gooseberry with center and fog lines has been completed. Stripping is being done on the reconstructed Wilson Road and includes a bike path on the south side.

The FHWA reconstruction of 5.9 miles of Willow Creek is in progress and is scheduled for completion in 1989. The county is providing the crushed rock produced by the county crusher located at Skinner Creek.

Preliminary work on the right-of-way surveying of 3.8 miles on the next phase of this project has been completed. With the completion date projected for this in 1990 this will complete the reconstruction of Willow Creek from Heppner to Cutsforth Park.
