Reconciliation is one of those words which we, on the one hand are very familiar with, and at the same time know very little about its practical application in our lives. If we talk about reconciling our check book with the bank statement or our business books with the actual activity of that business, most of us have very little difficulty. But when we apply the word to our relationships it would seem by our actions we are plowing new ground.

What is Reconciliation? Webster defines it as that activity or effort expended to restore, or harmonize relationships; to make congruous, to adjust or settle. The Bible describes it primarily as that operative work of God in restoring unto Himself His creation to their original purpose and position. Both definitions indicate that something has changed from the original and is in need or adjustment. With a bank statement the bank is usually the standard to which we need to adjust. With God He is the standard, for it was us who chose to be disobedient and thereby to incur His righteous wrath (Romans 5:1-11). And it is of no small importance that through it was God who wronged it was He who proffered the way through love to break the enmity (His toward us) and win by a free forgiveness, the very heart of the offenders.

We, too, are enjoined to pursue reconciliation with one another (Matthew 5:23-24). Freely we have received, freely we should give.

All it takes is a desire to put into effect the love which God so beautifully demonstrated to us in the giving of His son, Jesus Christ, that we should have newness of life, a life no longer lived to self and self interests, but a life lived to the one who gave it back to us. (II Cor. 5:11-21).
