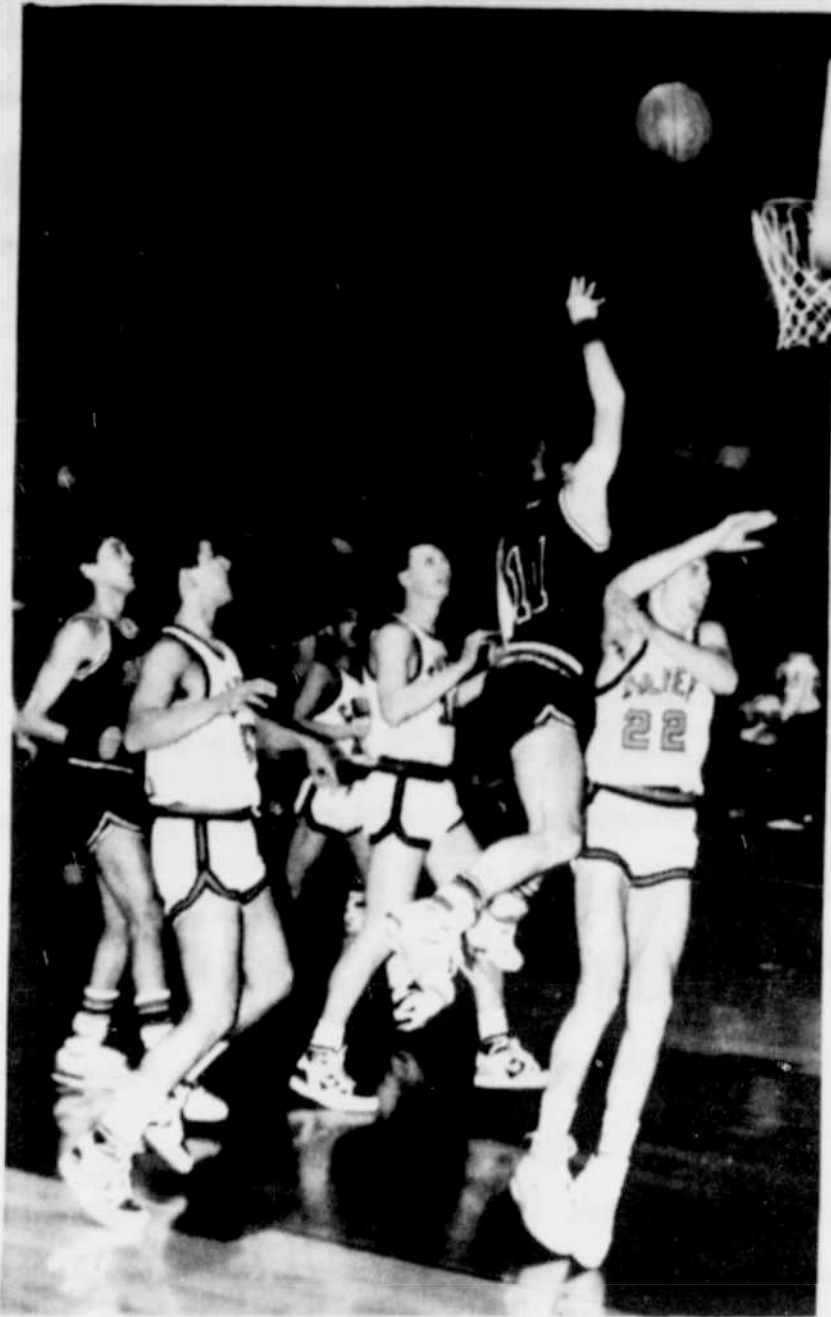


Culver wins make-up game with Ione
