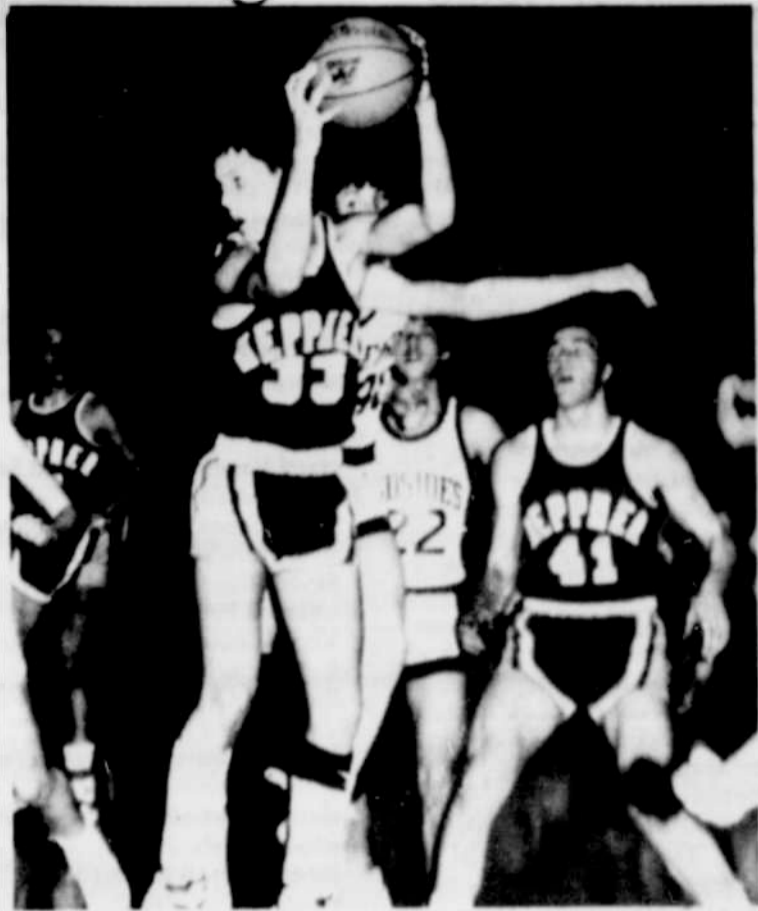


Mustangs end season at District

The Mustangs 1988-89 season came to an abrupt end Saturday as the Heppner boys lost to Wasco County at the District 7A basketball tournament in Pendleton 72-68.

Heppner had no answer as how to stop Wasco County's 6 foot 4 inch center, Myron Wilcox. Wilcox led the Redside with 29 points and 15 rebounds. Just when the Mustangs had him stopped he pushed the ball outside to Kevin Duling who buried three 3-point goals on the afternoon.

The game stayed close throughout the first quarter as Heppner took a 13-12 lead at the first break. Wilcox scored seven points to keep the Redside close.

The Redside started to pull away in the second quarter and before the Mustangs knew it, they were down by 10 with one minute left in the half 33-23. The Mustangs started to get

into foul trouble as Russell Britt picked up his third foul with two minutes left in the quarter and Bryan Padberg was called for his third with seven seconds left in the half. Wasco County went into the locker room with a 35-27 lead at the half.

It looked like things might go the Mustangs way in the third quarter as the Redside's sharpshooter Jason Schlager picked up his fourth foul with 6:40 left in the third quarter. But that's when Wilcox took over scoring 12 points in the period. The Redside raced to a 22 point lead with one minute left in the quarter. Slater Mitchell threw up a long range bomb that hit nothing but net to cut the Redside lead to 56-39, to end the third stanza.

Russell Britt ignited a fourth quarter rally by the Mustangs, scoring 15 points in the period. Dick

Devin sank a 3-point shot at the Buzzer but the Mustang comeback fell four points short.

The loss ended the season for the 13-7 Mustangs and dashed their dream of returning to the State tournament as they did in football earlier this fall.

Heppner was led by Britt's 27 points; Padberg, who left midway through the fourth quarter with a sprained ankle added 16. Devin had 15 points and led the Mustangs with 13 rebounds. Duling finished behind Wilcox with 18 points for the victorious Redside.

Heppner took an early lead behind Jennifer Currin's four first period points. Weston-McEwen's Dawn Shepard was sidelined late in the first quarter with two fouls so Heppner was able to go inside to Currin. After one period Heppner led 8-4.

Joy Glidewell picked up the slack for the Tiger Scots early in the second quarter, scoring the first three points.
