QUESTION

Shall Morrow County Levy \$3,438,336 outside the tax base for operating purposes for fiscal year 1989-90?

EXPLANATION

The purpose of this levy is to provide funds to balance the Morrow County operating budget for fiscal year 1989-90 which includes: Road Fund; County School Fund; Cities portion of Road Funds; Fair & Rodeo Fund; and General Fund (which provides funding for Extension Service, Weed Control District, Soil & Water Conservation District, Senior Services Coordinator, Neighborhood Council, Predatory Animal Damage Control, Museum, Justice Court, Juvenile Director, Soil Erosion Control, and Watermaster, as well as those services required by Oregon Law).

ONE YEAR OPERATING LEVY OUTSIDE THE TAX BASE.
QUESTION

Shall Morrow County levy \$400,000 outside the tax base for health care operations for fiscal year 1989-90?

EXPLANATION

The purpose of this levy is to provide funds to balance the Morrow County Medical Fund operating budget for fiscal year 1989-90. These funds are to provide health care services and emergency medical services for all communities, which includes North Morrow Medical Clinic, North Morrow Ambulance, Pioneer Memorial Hospital, and the communities of Irrigon, Lexington, and Ione. This levy is \$112 less than the levy approved by the voters for fiscal year 1988-89.

The Bonds will mature over a period not to exceed thirty (30) years.
