

"By My Hand" fibre show in second year

This fall the Country Fibre Artists' Guild of Heppner will host the opening of "By My Hand". This traveling fibre show, now in its second year, will feature handwoven items, handspun (knitted or crocheted) items, handfelting and basketry. Because no kits may be used, the works entered present a kaleidoscope of styles. Although the show is not juried, it is judged and the level of workmanship was very high last year. "By My Hand" provides local fiberists with an opportunity to showcase their works, compare their skills, and develop a market for those works which are for sale.

Heppner's guild is the organizing group for the show this year and area businesses are helping to sponsor it. Plans are well underway with the entry deadline set for Sept. 22. Judging will be done on Sept. 23 and the

first opening and reception are scheduled for October 1 at the Morrow County Museum in Heppner. The show will then travel to Pendleton, and LaGrande.

Country Fibre Artists' Guild welcomes new members and would like to see the scope of the guild increased. Many of the group are spinners, a few have tried weaving and currently the group is involved in a natural dye project. Interest has been shown in such diverse subjects as lockerhooking, color interpretation and tapestry. While many of the members of the guild are from the south-county area, there is no residence restriction. 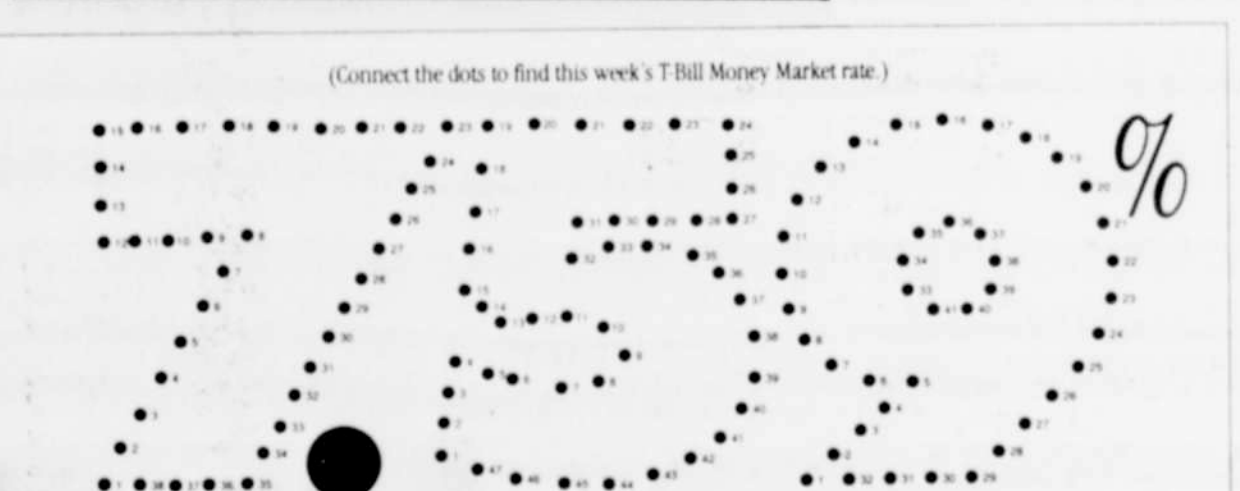
