musical numbers, comedy stand-up routines, even yodeling! Acts may be individuals or small groups, and are limited to six minutes or less (a pre-audition may be held prior to show).

Judges are Lea Calvert, Marie Struthers and Kevin Gutierrez. The emcee for the evening is Sharon Dawn of Athena.
