Pesticide collection days set

Pesticide Collection Days are September 6 and 7 this year, and will be at PGJ, Pendleton and Simplot, Umatilla respectively.

Pesticide Collection Days is a free opportunity to get rid of those empty pesticide containers that you have been collecting. It is an attempt by the Oregon Agricultural Chemical Association to deal positively with pesticide containers. If the program is successful, it should help avoid the passage of unnecessary legislation controlling pesticide container disposal.

This is a voluntary program which costs the grower nothing. It is a model program intended to avoid adding unnecessary addition costs to pesticides.

Volunteers at the collection sites will ask you to sign a certificate confirming that all pesticide containers have been triple rinsed, punctured both top and bottom, and crushed for easy transportation.

The site for collection are Pendleton Grain Growers, 127 NW 46th (McKinnon Station), Pendleton on September 6 only; and Simplot Soil Builders, Jones/Scott Landing, Umatilla, September 7, only.
