

### Sheriff's Report

The Sheriff's office at the courthouse in Heppner reports dispatching the following business during the past week:

August 11: Morrow County Sheriff's office responded to I-84 to attempt to locate a report of a possible intoxicated driver of a vehicle traveling eastbound. Located driver and problem resolved.
