## Umatilla refuge hunt applications available

Permits are required for the 1989/90 waterfowl and upland game hunting seasons on the McCormack Unit of Umatilla National Wildlife Refuge.

Waterfowl hunting applications are available by writing Umatilla National Wildlife Refuge, PO Box 239, Umatilla, OR 97882, or by calling the refuge at 503-922-3232. Applications for the first part of the season (October 14-November 25) must be submitted by September 15. Applications for the second half of the waterfowl season (November 26

end of waterfowl hunting season) must be submitted by November 1.

Advance permits for upland game hunting on the McCormack Unit are required for the opening weekend only. To apply submit a standard 3 1/2"x5 1/2" postcard with your name and address, and which day (Saturday or Sunday) you wish to hunt. Each hunter can apply for one day only. Postcards should be mailed to Umatilla Upland Game at the address above. The deadline for submitting upland game applications is September 15.
