

Topic club reviews book

"Polar Star" by Martin Cruz Smith was reviewed by Jean Nelson at the meeting of the Ione Topic Club on Wednesday, Oct. 25. Hostess for the day were Jean Nelson assisted by Rikka Tews and Maryan McElligott. A report on the fall money maker for the Ione Library showed a good response from the community.

"Polar Star" is a mystery story that centers around a murder on a Soviet factory ship making its way through the fog of the Bering Sea off Alaska. Its satellites are American trawler that catch the fish and sell them to the Russians to clean and process for freezing. The plot of the book builds relentlessly in the stark setting of the northern Pacific. With a cast of vivid characters, the novel is a successor to "Gorkey Park," Smith's previous book which has been made into a play and will soon be published in Moscow. "In spite of the thaw of Glasnost and Perestroika one still feels the restraint and distrust of the Russian people."

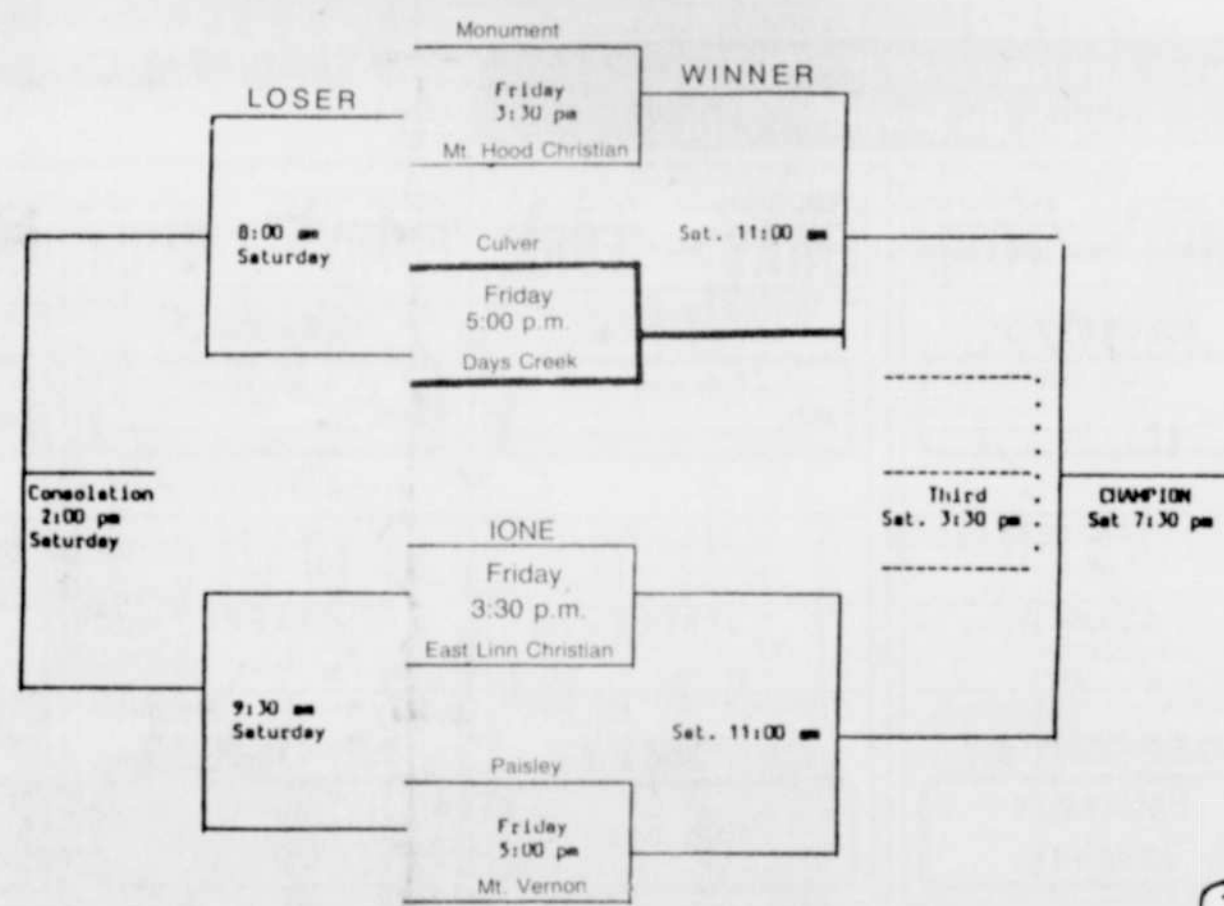
